**PROPERTY MANAGER'S REPORT**  
**After Hurricane Irma**  
**September 12, 2017**

Breakers West Residents, Hurricane Irma has now passed and it is time to clean up. Luckily, there is minimal clean up. Solid Waste Authority will resume our normal schedule for household and recycle pickup only. Please do not put your trash out until tomorrow after 6:00 am because the roads and walkways are full of landscape debris that is being cleaned up. See below for specific trash pickup information:

- **Household Garbage pickup only** will be on Wednesday and Saturday. Do not put your trash out before morning of pick up. **Recyclables** to be picked up on Wednesdays only.
- Solid Waste Authority is asking that garbage be placed in **3 separate piles**. One pile for landscape debris. Landscape Debris may not be picked up right away so if you are placing landscape at the street it must not be in the road. If you live on the cul-de-sac emergency vehicles must be able to go around the turn. This includes the large Solid Waste trucks. Garbage cans and bags should be placed in a separate area, and then the recycle bins.
- Landscape and Household garbage should not be placed by:
  - Mailboxes because there is mail delivery
  - Fire hydrants
  - Storm Drains, BWA is still cleaning the drains
  - Utility boxes so that Comcast and AT&T may access for repairs
